SPCA Breaks Monthly Adoption Record

The SPCA has surpassed it's all time adoption record for a single month and the total keeps growing.

In June of this year we had a record setting 163 adoptions. Through July of 2006 the total adoptions were 892 animals so we are on track to have a record setting year as well.

In 2002 the total adoptions were 935. In 2003 the total adoptions were 1141. In 2004 the total adoptions were 1261. In 2005 the total adoptions were 1166 animals.
