

2019 Washington County SPCA **INTAKES**

- On January 1, 2019, 225 were in our care
- We received 2,682 animals
- 1,850 were stray or abandoned
- 832 were owner surrendered
- On December 31, 2019, 275 animals were in our care

2019 Washington County SPCA **OUTCOMES**

- 1,033 animals were adopted
- 222 were returned to owner
- 665 were transferred to rescue partners
- 400 animals died in our care (animals born from unhealthy mothers or illness that did not respond to treatment)
- 285 animals were euthanized due to extreme illness or aggression


